He is also President of the Hong Kong Continence Society, and a council member of the International Association of Gerontology (IAG) and the Asia/Oceania Region of IAG.

Dr Leung serves as the convenor of the Federation of Long Term Care in Chinese Communities, and co-convenor of the Scientific Subcommittee of Clinical Medicine of the Asia/Oceania Region of IAG.

His major research interests include epidemiology in old age, health promotion, osteoporosis, end of life care, falls, stroke, incontinence, long-term care and public policy in old age.

Dr Leung has been chief editor of the Hong Kong Journal of Gerontology, and is currently co-chief editor of the Asian Journal of Gerontology and Geriatrics. He has been widely published in local and international journals, and has been a contributor to a many books on health and ageing.

Furthermore, he has been invited to lecture at various symposiums in Korea, Japan, Singapore, Australia, China, Macau and Taiwan.

Dr Leung is an advocate for the importance of end of life care for older people in the community.
