Dr Hannah Seymour is a Consultant Geriatrician and Medical Lead of the West Australian Electronic Medical Record Program.

In 2005, Dr Seymour completed her medical training in Western Australia, since which she has served as a Consultant Geriatrician.

Dr Seymour sits on the board and committees for a range of regional and international organisations. She is Co-Chair of the Asia Pacific Fragility Fracture Alliance (APFFA) Hip Fracture Registry Working Group, sits on the Steering Committee of the ANZ Hip Fracture Registry (ANZHFR), and is President Elect of the Fragility Fracture Network (FFN).

She has held several leadership positions in Western Australia, including the Falls and Aged Care Lead in the Department of Health, Leadership of the Four-Hour Rule Program at Royal Perth Hospital, and Clinical Commissioning Lead at Fiona Stanley Hospital. Most recently, she was the Clinical Nominee on the Sustainable Health Review, which was published in April 2019.

Her research interests include utilising data to improve the care of older people with hip fractures worldwide. Dr Seymour has presented internationally on the care of older people with fractures.
